## COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY 01/2017

A Commission of Enquiry was held on the 24<sup>th</sup> August 2017 at 18H00 to investigate the following charges brought against Drift Spin Drag Motor Club.

- 1) Whether DSDMC held an event on the 01<sup>st</sup> July 2017 without a permit as required in GCR 80.
- 2) Whether Sr's were submitted for the event of the 01<sup>st</sup> July 2017 as required in GCR 143(v).
- 3) Whether C of C and Race Reports were submitted as required in GCR 143(ix)(a) and 143(ix)(e)
- 4) Whether Day License Fees were paid over to the NMSF after the event

The Court President opened the Enquiry by reading the charges to the defendants in order for them to understand why the enquiry was called.

After a lengthy discussion, the DSDMC admitted that they were guilty as charged on all accounts and it was established by the Enquiry that this was done out of frustration and in protest as they felt that they were not being heard by the NMSF regarding issues that were previously addressed by them and that other Clubs were not being taken to task over transgressions committed.

The Court members took time to deliberate arrived at the following findings:

On charges 1,2 and 3, the DSDMC was found guilty and for this a recommendation will be made to the NMSF Council that they be given a suspended sentence from 24<sup>th</sup> August till 31<sup>st</sup> December is so much as should the DSDMC hold an event without submitting SR's, obtain a permit or not submit race reports, the NMSF will convene a Court Of Enquiry and take further action.

On charge number 4, the Court felt that it would recommend to the NMSF Council that the DSDMC be fined a fee of double the Day licenses sold for not submitting documents to that effect and not depositing the monies collected into the NMSF's bank account. Fine equal to ND 1400.00

The Court made it clear to the DSDMC that as this was merely a Commission of Enquiry, recommendations for penalties will be forwarded to the NMSF Council for discussion, ratification or further action.
