Enduro Circuit Safety Officers

Safety / control officers / Marshals will be located at pre designated spots along the Enduro Circuit. Safety officers shall be placed in such a manner that quick and efficient response is ensured. Their responsibility is to manage all aspects for the safe running of the section assigned, including the spectator areas.

These Marshals and their assistants are in direct communication to the Event control (COC and Chief Medical Coordinator) via the event radio network and / or GSM mobile telephones. Each officer and their Medical assistants will have been thoroughly briefed on the following:

- Familiarity of the terrain and the unique safety issues on this event.
- Basic First Aid training. (Basic life support)
- An understanding of the emergency and evacuation procedures.

They will also be provided with an extensive first aid kit in their vehicles to be carried by the medical support basic life support persons.

Casualty Evacuation

1. Marshall to contact COC and race control,
2. COC to inform CMC
3. CMC to activate nearest medical team.
4. Marshall and paramedic to evacuate rider to Race / Medical Control Station;
5. Rider to be stabilized and then transported to hospital via ambulance;
6. Helicopter and fixed wing on standby in extreme cases.

Emergency Calls to Event Control

In the case of an emergency, Event Control will be notified either by telephone or over the radio network. Officials and assistants are advised to try and use the telephone before the radio network.

In either case, the person making the phone / radio call and the Event Control Officer responding

to the telephone / radio call should:

- Identify themselves.
- Provide their location and telephone number if appropriate.
- Give a brief assessment of the situation including the information regarding:
 - Nature of the emergency
 - Number of casualties
 - Nature of the injuries
- Await further instructions from Event Control.
- Designate a person to man their radio / telephone at ALL TIMES.

Emergency Evacuation

The ambulance will be stationed at Race Control (**Elisenheim Enduro**) **Khomas/Namibia**.

During hours of operation, the marshals and medical crew will remain on radio / telephone standby at all times and report to the Event Control on every take off and landing.

Casualties, regardless of the nature of their injuries, which cannot be handled by the Medical Crew for the event, will be taken to the nearest hospital as listed.

Emergency Evacuation Overview

The following is a brief overview of the evacuation procedure:

- Event Control will request all emergency evacuation directly to the Chief Medical Coordinator.
- Marshals and medical crew will attend to the evacuation location from their stand by position at the respective sectional points.
- The CMC, upon assessing the overall status of the injured will decide whether the casualty is safe to be treated at the Medical / Race Control Station, transported to Windhoek via ambulance which will be stationed at the Event Headquarters or fly the injured directly to a hospital in Windhoek.
- Whatever the decision, the COC shall be notified about the decision immediately.
- COC and the CMC will advise the relevant hospital of the incoming casualties, the number, and nature of injuries and their approximate time of arrival.

Emergency Evacuation Procedure at Race Track

In case of an emergency evacuation, the following procedure will be followed:

- The COC in conjunction with the Marshal in charge of the section will confirm with Race/Event Control whether the section is completely blocked or not. Most of the times the casualty will be attended to by the closest placed Medical Team. They would also inform the Race/Event Control as to which pre-designated site the casualty will be moved to. This should leave the section passable by subsequent competitors.
- Race/Event Control will stop the competition, **only if absolutely required**, and instruct the Start Control, and the COC in the section prior to where the accident has occurred, to stop further motorcycle entering the section.
- In either case, Event Control/COC will advise the medical team that an emergency evacuation is required providing:
 - Location of the casualty / casualties
 - Any description of the incident available
 - Potential number of casualties
- Event Control will advise the hospital/s that:
 - Casualties are en-route and the approximate time of their arrival.
 - Number of casualties and nature of injuries.
- In case where the Event Chief Medical Coordinator or Advanced Life Support Paramedic has to travel with the casualty, Event Control will advise the next highest Qualified Paramedic to take over in the interim.
- Once all the casualties have been transferred, the ambulance will return to the site medical station.
- The Marshall will remain at the site of the incident until all casualties have been evacuated or treated and advise Event Control prior to leaving the location.

Medical Team

The Medical Team will comprise of the following:

- 1 Team consisting of 8 members: 1 x BLS, 2 x ILS, and 2 x ECT and x3 ALS stationed at **Elisenheim, Enduro (Komas region)**.
- Medical Practitioners are on duty at relevant hospitals.

Medical Equipment

The Service Park will have:

- A Medical facility/room/tent with facilities to provide treatment to a casualty.
- A fully loaded ambulance with 2 trained paramedics (ALS or ECT or ILS or BLS).
- A rapid response unit to reach, initiate treatment and facilitate transport to Race / Medical Control Station (Rhino ATV / designated all-terrain vehicle).
