4. **JURISDICTION**

It will be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation International de Automobile (FIA), the General Competition Rules and Standing Supplementary Regulations of the NMSF and these Supplementary Regulations, together with additional bulletins and amendments, and will be open to those competitors who are domiciled within the area of jurisdiction of the NMSF and who are holders of an appropriate license.

6. PLACE, DATE & TIME OF THE EVENT

The event will take place at the Tony Rust Racetrack on the 25, 26 & 27th April 2019. The event will commence on Thursday 5pm and will end on Saturday before midnight.

7. <u>DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT</u>

An Exhibition event to promote motorsports in Namibia by exhibiting the various motorsport codes over three days as well as hosting 4 promotional events as entertainment for the spectators. None of the events are counting towards any club or national championships and are solely part of the exhibition. The events are 1/8 mile or 1/4 mile drags, Spinning, Drifitng and Gymkhana.

Gates open Friday 26/04/2019 @ 17h00 1/8 mile Drag starts 19h00 until 21h00 Drift and Gymkhana fillers Expo closes

Gates open Saturday 27/04/2019 @ 10h00 for the public Exhibition runs until 16h00 Track is cleared for Gymkhana to start at 18h00 Drifting starts immediately after Gymkhana Music entertainment follows and Expo closes and concludes at midnight

9. ENTRIES

- 9.1 No entries will be accepted on the weekend. Only pre-entered competitors will be allowed to take part in the various events. Entries are on invitation only.
- 9.2 All competitors will complete the required documents and indemnity forms.
- 9.3 Entry Fee Drivers taking part in the events will receive a free weekend pass as their participation is part on entertainment.
 - 9.3.1 NMSF One Event License N\$200.00
- 9.5 The organizers may, with the consent of the Stewards, permit a change of car and/or class or driver on written application by the entrant, not later than one hour before the event, provided that either a change of car (and/or class) or driver is required, but not both (GCR104(vii), GCR115).
- 9.6 Every Entrant/Driver shall sign the declaration in terms of GCR 97/98.
- 9.7 No unauthorized persons or unsupervised children under the age of 16 will be allowed in the pit area during the events.

10. STARTING POSITIONS

Starting positions will be determined by the COC of the different Events

11. <u>DOCUMENTATION</u>

Documentation will be done 1 hour before each days event commences.

13. PROTESTS & APPEALS

There will be no Protests or Appeals as this is an exhibition.

14. PENALTIES AND EXCLUSIONS

There will be no penalties or exclusions as this is an exhibition. However, should a competitor be guilty of any transgressions, the Stewards of the event can refer the competitor to the NMSF for sanctions.

19. <u>IDENTIFICATION AND PUBLICITY</u>

Any competitor not displaying advertising material, if provided by the Organizers for the duration of the event will not be allowed to continue taking part in the event.

21. **GENERAL**

Littering, reckless driving and/or excessive noise and unsporting behavior by support crews will result in the following punitive measures to be instigated:

- 21.1 Team's exclusion from the final results
- 21.2 Reports to NMSF
- 21.3 Right to refuse entry in future events.

22. General Race Day Rules:

- Appropriate racing wear as per SSR 400
- Alcohol will not be tolerated inside the Pit Area
- No unauthorized people allowed in Pit Area
- All children under 16 under adult supervision
- Cars/Bikes coming late and or drivers not present during scruitinering will under no circumstances will be allowed to race in any event.
- Races will be called out ONLY ONCE. Drivers not lining up immediately will not be allowed to race.

• ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION:

• A NO TOLERANCE policy is maintained with regard to alcohol consumption by anyone present in the pit area. This includes mechanics, crew, representatives, supporters, family and the friends. The competitor, or in the case of a minor, his/her representative, shall be responsible for the people in their pit area. If anyone is caught consuming alcohol or being under the influence of alcohol in the pit area, it may result in immediate disqualification of the rider/competitor. This will apply even if you have finished the event.

Committee:





- There may be a breathalyser present at the event and breath alcohol tests may be conducted in a
 random fashion by the Chief Medical Officer at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The Clerk of
 the Course may also have any individual rider, competitor, crew member and representative suspected
 of being under the influence of alcohol, tested by the CMO.
- IF THE BREATH ALCOHOL TEST INDICATES ANY PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL, THE RIDER/COMPETITOR COULD BE EXCLUDED FROM THE RACE.
