It will be held under the international sporting code of the Federation International De Automobile (FIA), the general competition rules and standing supplementary regulations, together with additional bulletins and amendments, and will be open to those competitors who are domiciled within the area of jurisdiction of the NMSF and who are holders of an appropriate license.

6. PLACE, DATE & TIME

Gates open at 10 o'clock in the morning on Saturday and close at 19:00 pm on the same day.

The spinning event on Saturday will start in the morning at 13pm to 19H00pm.

7. DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

A spinning event as contained in the 2014 Standing Supplementary Regulations for spinning and approved by the NMSF.

The event will not be open to the public however is hosted to promote the sport.

9. **ENTRIES**

- 9.1 Entries for the event are closed to the public, invited participants only.
- 9.2 No entry will be accepted unless submitted on the official entry form
- 9.3 An entry fee of N\$150-00. NMSF Day License fee.

- 9.5 The organisers may, with the consent of the stewards, permit a change of car and/or Driver on written application by the entrant, not later than one hour before the event begins. This will only be allowed if a new driver adheres to these regulations.
- 9.6 Every entrant/ driver shall sign the declaration in terms of GCR97.
- 9.7 Each entrant will be entitled to 2 pit tickets per vehicle.
- 9.8 **No unauthorized persons allowed in the pit area.**

ALCOHOL WILL NOT BE TOLERATED INSIDE THE PIT AREA GCR 122

ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION:

A NO TOLERANCE policy is maintained with regard to alcohol consumption by anyone present in the pit area. This includes mechanics, crew, representatives, supporters, family and the friends. The competitor, or in the case of a minor, his/her representative, shall be responsible for the people in their pit area. If anyone is caught consuming alcohol or being under the influence of alcohol in the pit area, it may result in immediate disqualification of the rider/competitor. This will apply even if you have finished the event.

There may be a breathalyser present at the event and breath alcohol tests may be conducted in a random fashion by the Chief Medical Officer at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The Clerk of



the Course may also have any individual rider, competitor, crew member and representative suspected of being under the influence of alcohol, tested by the CMO.

IF THE BREATH ALCOHOL TEST INDICATES ANY PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL, THE RIDER/COMPETITOR COULD BE EXCLUDED FROM THE RACE.
