RE: RESUMPTION OF MOTORSPORT IN NAMIBIA DURING COVID-19

On the 24th July 2020, the NMSF Council consulted and resolved that motorsport in Namibia may resume subject to the following conditions which shall be adhered to:

PRE-EVENT:

- With reference to the **NMSF By-Law No.01/2020 point 18**, dated the 10th June 2020, Organisers and Officials training with regards to the Covid-19 will be provided via a Zoom Webinar. Date and time to be communicated to all clubs.
- With reference to a the” **Process going forward” Circular point 4**, dated 25th June 2020, a clear logistical/practical protocol plan/guide outlining how the safety protocols will be adhered to for each event must be submitted to the NMSF with the event SR’s no later than 3 weeks prior to the event.
- Kindly note, to obtain permission to host events from the Namibia Sports Commission, the attached form must be completed and submitted with the SR’s to the NMSF Administrator. **Further note, despite all conditions being met, the Namibia Sports Commission reserves the right to refuse permission for an event to take place.**
- As the calendar has been submitted to the Namibia Sports Commission, no application for date shifts/movement of dates will be considered. The calendar as the proposed dates is fixed.

EVENT

- With reference to the **NMSF By-Law No.01/2020**, dated the 10th June 2020, all NMSF protocols including the Namibia State of Emergency protocols are to be adhered to.
- **Kindly note, no spectators will be allowed until further notice.**
- **A maximum of 4 personnel per competition vehicle will be allowed for now. This number could be increased at a later stage.**
- **The use of Hookah pipes at events will not be allowed. The onus is on the organisers to ensure that Hookah pipes are not smoked at events.**
- A contact register, see attached, shall be correctly completed by all in attendance
- There shall be no sharing of apparel or equipment





POST EVENT

- The attendance register must be submitted to the NMSF by the first Tuesday after the event which in turn must be submitted by the NMSF to the Namibia Sports Commission.
- With reference to the **NMSF By-Law No.01/2020 point 16**, dated the 10th June 2020, organisers are to hold a debriefing and a full report must be submitted to the NMSF no later than 7 days after the event.
- Failure to submit the register and report will result in no further permits being issued.

It is imperative that the protocols are strictly adhered to as the personal safety of everyone must be put first. The NMSF Council would not like its members and affiliates to be the one responsible for the spread of the Covid-19 virus.
